

Bach/Baroque Festival, March 28 2021

March 12 Online deadline for Bach/Baroque Festival.

Date of Festival: Sunday, March 28, 12PM-5PM. Fee: \$30.00 Time limit: 5 minutes. Online zoom audition.

All Southern California Junior Bach Festival entries and registration must be made on-line at www.scjbf.org.

This festival is designed to stimulate interest in the music of J.S. Bach and the Baroque Period. Up to 35% of those performing compositions by J.S. Bach may be selected to perform at the Regional Festival. Selections from the Anna Magdalena Notebook are eligible only for the Branch Festival. Those appearing at the Regional Festival, performing appropriate repertoire, are eligible to compete in the Complete Works Audition. This is an adjudicated event. Participating students will receive written evaluations from the judges.

Vocalists, wind and string players will compete in their own All Southern California Junior Bach Festival. Please note: Vocalists, wind and string players who would like to perform music by Baroque composers other than J.S. Bach may play at the local Glendale Branch Festival. Students may present only one selection. All performances must be memorized with the exception of flute and ensemble works with two or more equal parts. Judges' decisions are final. Time limit: 5 minutes.

The Regional Festival will be an adjudicated event. 45% of those performing may be chosen to receive Regional Awards. Only Regional winners are eligible to perform in the Complete Works Audition providing the repertoire is from the Complete Works' List.
